

## INTRODUCING THE CIRC – BUILDING STRONGER REFERRAL RELATIONSHIPS THROUGH EDUCATION (PART 4)

By the time participants reach Session 4 in the Comprehensive Implant Restorative Continuum through Martel Academy, they move into one of the most practical and transformative parts of the program: successful implant prosthetics. The focus turns to real-world prosthetic procedures for multiple implant cases. Instructors emphasize predictable workflows that minimize complications and maximize longevity.

Abutment selection plays a central role. Participants learn how to choose the right abutments based on specific clinical situations, considering factors like tissue thickness, angulation, and emergence profiles. The session covers both stock and custom options, helping dentists make informed decisions that support optimal esthetics and function.

A key discussion revolves around cement-retained versus screw-retained restorations. Attendees weigh the pros and cons of each approach, including retrievability, esthetics, and maintenance considerations. This knowledge helps practices select the best option for individual patient needs while avoiding common pitfalls.

Impression techniques receive hands-on attention as well. From traditional methods to digital workflows, dentists gain confidence in capturing accurate records that lead to well-fitting prostheses. The session includes tips for troubleshooting and ensuring precision when working with labs or specialists.

Throughout the day, real-world case analysis brings everything together. Participants review actual patient scenarios, discuss challenges encountered, and explore solutions that deliver outstanding outcomes. This interactive format reinforces learning and builds the clinical judgment essential for everyday practice.

Session 4 bridges the gap between planning and delivery, giving GPs the tools to confidently restore implants and strengthen collaboration with surgical partners. Practices that complete this training often see higher case acceptance, better results, and more referrals flowing in both directions.
